- All students who enter will receive a certificate and their artwork will be eligible for ribbons and awards. Entries must be postmarked by March 1, 2015 or delivered to the Helen C. Fenske Visitor Center during visitor center hours.
- Students will be judged in four groups according to grade levels (K - 12). Their artwork can feature ducks, swans, or geese

in their natural habitat.
