- Join us on **Sunday, January 11, 2015 from 11:00 to Noon**, when the Friends of Great Swamp NWR will host an orientation program at the Helen C. Fenske Visitor Center at the refuge on the Junior Duck Stamp Program contest rules.
- Students are judged in four groups according to grade level (K - 12). Designs can feature ducks, swans, or geese in their

natural habitat. Students who enter will receive a certificate and their artwork will be eligible for awards.
